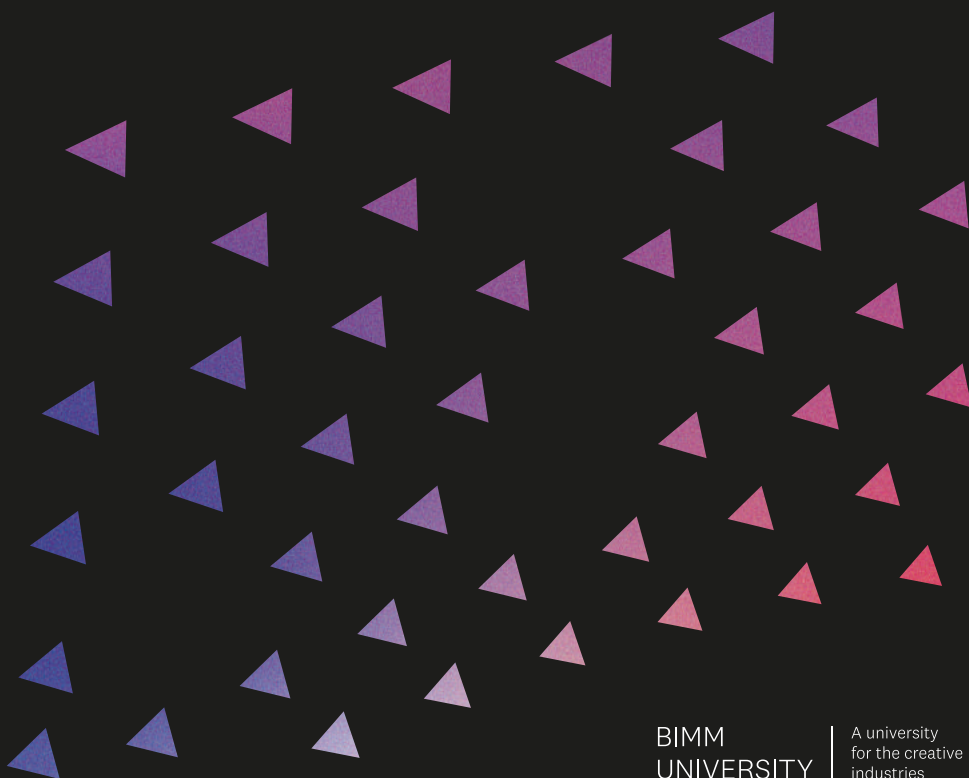

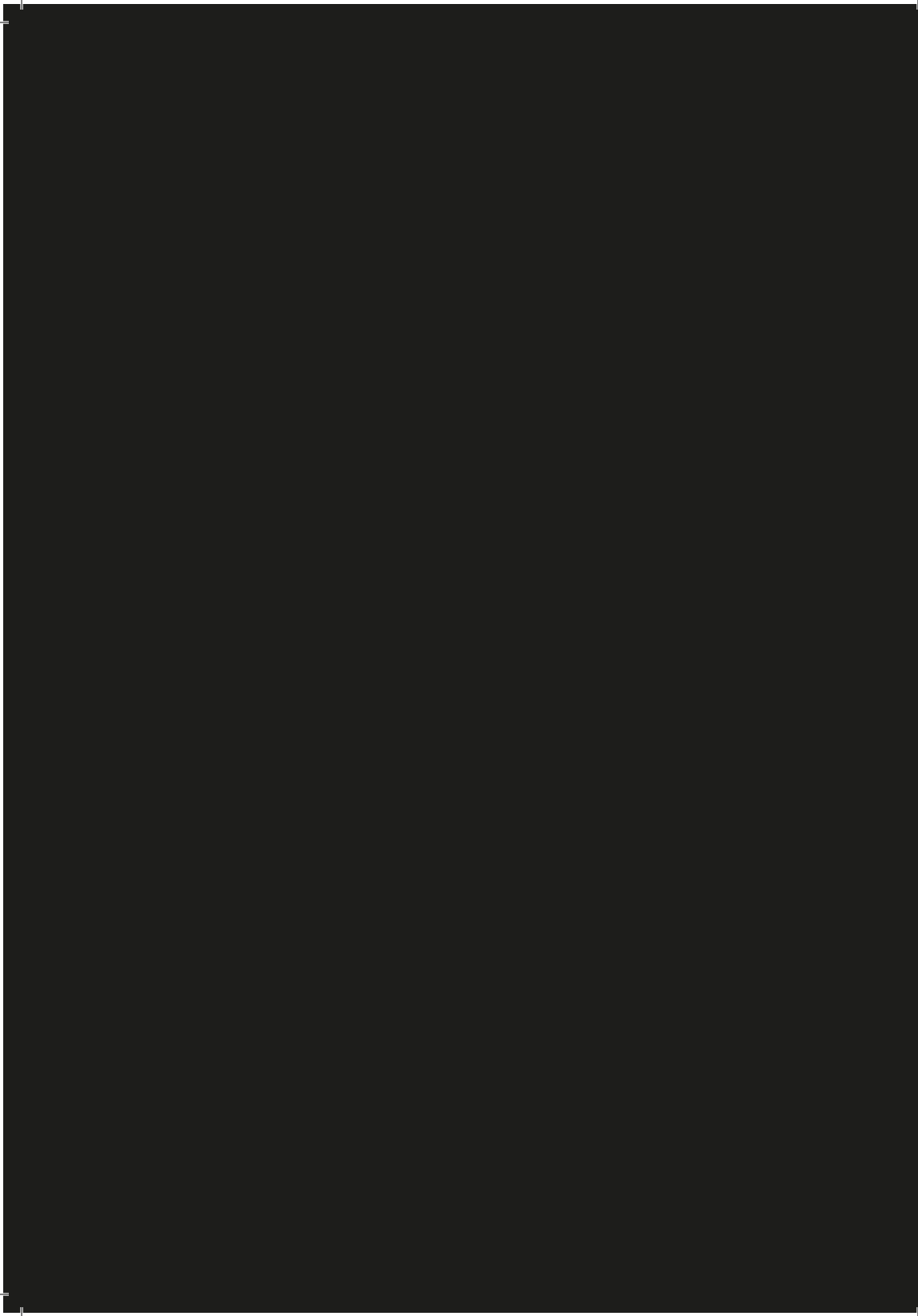

Berlin

Welcome to Berlin. This is where one of the most diverse and welcoming creative scenes in the world unites in the name of collaboration and exploration. From experimental music forms to trailblazing cinematic aesthetics, Berlin is the perfect place to let your creativity run free.

The music and film industries in Berlin

Berliners live and breathe music. The industry here is extremely diverse, with every single genre imaginable – and others you may never have – represented by labels, venues and festivals large and small.

The film and television industry in Berlin is alive and kicking: production companies are booked up for months in advance and there is a shoot unfolding on every street corner. In recent years, the city has set the scene for film and TV productions including Kleo, Spencer, Uncharted, The Matrix Resurrections, Babylon Berlin, Tár, The Queen's Gambit and more.

BIMM Institute Berlin facilities

The iconic House of Music is home to our state-of-the-art music facilities. Facilities include an acoustically designed live room and a control room for professional recording, mixing and mastering – ideal for audio recording and post-production. Our in-house studio includes outboard equipment and hardware from the

likes of Neve, ADAM Audio, SSL and Neumann. Our rehearsal and performance rooms are equipped with a professional backline from manufacturers such as Roland, Nord, Sonor and Shure. Our Mac suites feature digital audio workstations like Ableton, Pro Tools and Logic Pro, and are loaded with plug-ins from iZotope, Fab Filter, Sound Toys and many more.

Our purpose-built filmmaking facilities are based at Molecule Studios and deliver the environment of a working film facility and post-production house. The space features a professional-standard screening room equipped with an 8K projector and 5.1 surround sound, plus video editing and sound suites. We offer students access to industry-leading cinematic cameras such as the Sony Fx9 and the Blackmagic URSA plus sound and lighting equipment from ARRI, Aputure and Sound Devices.

No matter whether you're studying music or film, you'll be working with the same equipment, tech and tools used by the industry today.

With some of Hamburg's most vibrant venues and music companies around us, students also have the unique opportunity to use facilities at real-world companies and venues including Chefrog Studios and live music venue the Jolly Jumper.

Step 1: Submit your application

Head to bimm-institute.de/direct-application to start your application.



Step 3: Complete your interview

One of our lecturers will be your interviewer and will review any supporting material you submit in advance.

The interview will last 30 minutes and will cover your experience to date, your course and career aspirations, and feedback on your pre-submitted materials.

At the end of the interview, our lecturer will inform you on the outcome. A member of the Admissions Team will then be in touch about the next steps.



Step 2: Book your interview

We'll contact you to arrange your interview. You can choose whether you want to complete your interview online or in-person at one of our colleges. You will also receive all the information you need on what to prepare and submit before your interview.

Step 4: Receive an offer of study

There are two types of offers you can receive: conditional (pending academic, English language or visa requirements) or unconditional (you've met all academic and visa requirements).

You will receive your offer via our Application Portal. It also contains information on next steps including semester dates, deposit and fee guidance, and advice on planning your move to study.



Step 5: Accepting your offer and paying your deposit

If you decide to accept your offer of study, your deposit needs to be paid within 14 days to secure your place. Guidance on this can be found in your offer letter and further advice is available from the Admissions Team.



Step 6: Next steps and enrolment

Time to get ready to start your studies! Before you join us, you will receive further useful information from the Admissions Team to help you prepare. This includes useful tips on finding accommodation, settling in and health insurance. You can download helpful documents at bimm-institute.de/essential-documents.

Enrolment begins approximately two months prior to the start of semester one. Our Enrolment Support Team will provide information to guide you through each step, so keep an eye on your emails! Your timetable and virtual learning resources will be available around two weeks before classes begin.

Entry requirements



Academic requirements

All BIMM Institute courses have academic entry criteria. You'll need to provide us with proof of your qualifications when you make your application, so we recommend making scans of these to upload to your Application Portal. Alternatively, you can email them across to the Admissions Team.

Depending on the course, an Abitur of 3.0/3.4 or equivalent is the minimum grade.

English language requirements

All BIMM Institute courses are taught in English. If your first language isn't English, and you haven't studied an English qualification during your education which is recognised by BIMM Institute, we will require a stand-alone proof of English-language certificate from an approved examining body. This will need to meet a minimum grade of 10 on the English Component (Leistungsfach) in the Abitur or the required B2 Level within the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR), and please note that the English language equivalencies can vary between courses.
